

## Inkawasi – House of the Incachildren



Inkawasi is a non-profit Organisation that helps children from poor backgrounds in Cajamarca. Cajamarca is a city with approximately one hundred thousand inhabitants situated in the Northern Peruvian highlands. International and Peruvian volunteers take care of 30-40 children on a daily basis. These children grow up with their mothers and many siblings in conditions of severe poverty, often without electricity, running water, and daily alimentation.

Their family's lack of income makes it often impossible for the children to attend school. These same children are obliged to start working at a very young age, to help their families. Many of our children work as porters, sell sweets, and help at night in bakeries.

Due to their situation they are exposed to a series of risks, including drug consumption and prostitution.

The Organisation's aims to improve the children's health and alimentation, as well as to offer an education that will enable them to have a better future.

## How do we finance our project?

Inkawasi is a private Organisation, that does not receive any financial help from the Peruvian government. All of our financial support comes from international donations and through our own fundraising initiatives. This covers the salaries of our professional staff, expenses for the children along with rent and electricity.



## Inkawasi Support Association

In October 2005, in Wetzlar (Germany), an association for the development of Incawasi was founded. The aim of this association is to gather financial support for our Non-profit Organisation in Peru (Inkawasi). These fund-raising campaigns and the support of our 'god-parents' ensure the future of our work with the children.

## How can you help?

### Expenses

You can help us with a small donation. Here is a list to give you an idea of our daily costs:

- €2 A nice book for children
- €3 Breakfast for 34 children/day
- €6 A pair of school shoes
- €10 Lunch for 34 children/day
- €50 Yearly school expenses/child

### Godparents

Along with donations, we also look for Godparents for Incawasi (a monthly donation of 5€). This money pays for the children's school expenses for a whole year. Godparents can also maintain a correspondence with their child, allowing them more contact and insight into their child's progress.

### Corporate Sponsorship

In order to have the means to plan our future as an Institution and to ensure Incawasi's long-term success, we also search for frequent donations in the form of corporate sponsorship.

## A day in the life of Incawasi

When the children arrive at 9am they have breakfast followed by some time to play and chat together. At 10am, classes begin, in which the children receive help with their homework along with general support to reinforce their education.

Lunch is change over time. The morning classes finish at 12, the children have lunch and then go to school. The afternoon children arrive any time after 12.30, have lunch and play a little, and then from 2 to 4 pm they have classes with the volunteers.



At 4 pm the afternoon kids get a nutritious snack before they go home.

We frequently organize activities and excursions for the children, including horseback riding and swimming lessons,<sup>ooo</sup> amongst others.

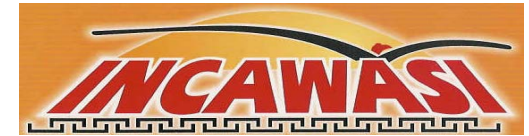
